# Minutes Annual Business Meeting

# Massachusetts Fruit Growers' Association, Inc.

Center of New Hampshire Holiday Inn, Manchester, NH December 14, 2005

The Annual Business Meeting was called to order at 12:20 PM by President Ken Nicewicz. President Nicewicz offered words of welcome to the membership. Twenty-four individuals were present.

#### Secretary's Report

Directors met on March 8 and November 2, 2005. Trustees of the MFGA Horticultural Research Fund met on March 4, 2005. The Annual Summer Meeting was on July 18, 2005 at Nicewicz Family Farm. Approximately 75 individuals attended the meeting. The Annual Business Meeting will be on December 14, 2005 at noon in the Armory (Expo Center of New Hampshire, Manchester).

One-hundred and forty-four individuals were members of the Association in 2005, similar to 2004. Additionally, 26 individuals have committed to a \$2,500 contribution to the University of Massachusetts Foundation to match the Massachusetts Society for Promoting Agriculture's \$50,000 pledge and the State's \$57,500 match. This group includes 3 life members, 3 courtesy members, 2 associate members, and 17 active members. These individuals will be given 10 years of membership, beginning in 2006. Below are the membership figures for 1996-2005.

It was moved, seconded, and passed to accept the Secretary's Report. Autio presented the minutes from the December 15, 2004 Annual Business Meeting. The minutes were moved, seconded, and passed unanimously.

### Treasurer's Report

The General Fund began the year with a balance of \$45,956.78. Receipts totaled \$41,562.18, and disbursements totaled \$46,773.09. The balance on December 31, 2005 was \$40,745.87. The Horticultural Research Fund began the year with a balance of \$532,531.37. A total of \$56,077.17 in receipts and \$125,448.69 expenses occurred in 2005. Of the expenses, \$10,000 was donated to the UMass Foundation to contribute to an endowment in support of tree-fruit IPM research established by Linda Prokopy, \$50,000 was donated to the UMass Foundation as part of a pledge of \$250,000 over 5 years, and \$52,932.83 was donated to the UMass Foundation as part of a matching fund program with the Massachusetts Society for Promoting Agriculture. The balance in the Horticultural Research Fund on December 31, 2005 was \$542,708.05. In 2005, the Horticultural Research Fund gained 1.9% in value (including income and expenses). The overall investment return was 15.0%. At the end of 2005, there was additionally a total of approximately \$450,424 in the UMass Foundation under the direction of the MFGA Trustees of the Horticultural Research Fund, giving a total of approximately \$993,132 in endowment moneys under MFGA control and in support of work at the UMass Cold Spring Orchard Research & Education Center. The Treasurer's Report was moved, seconded and passed. *Please note that the data presented here are modified from those presented at the meeting, reflecting the final activity and balances of 2005*. Details follow.

No additional nominations were received from the floor, and a motion was made to direct the Secretary to cast a single ballot for the slate of candidates as nominated..
